Today saw us welcome back some more of our pupils and staff that are returning to school, as we begin to increase pupil numbers as per Government guidelines.

It was so nice to see their faces again and to introduce them back into school with our new regimes in place.

As mentioned previously, the measures we have introduced are taking temperatures and hand sanitizing on arrival, lots of handwashing throughout the day, small class sizes (bubbles) and a strict ruling that no more than 4 pupils are allowed in any one space at one time (ie., the garden or playground).

We do have PPE on site, but as the majority of the pupils are more anxious when they see us in masks or face shields, the staff body as a whole have agreed not to use

them, unless essential, so as to allay any fears or anxieties the children may have.
