Plan A

This is the information given in the current Covid Risk Assessment

Plan B

Full student attendance can be maintained with the following numbers of the school's own staff or familiar agency present to ensure safety of our young people.

Class	Minimum number of SSAs / TAs
Acorn	5 staff including 1 agency
Maple	5 staff including 1 agency
Willow	7 staff including 2 agency
Beech	5 staff including 1 agency
Oak	5 staff including 1 agency
Hazel	3 staff including 1 agency
Pine	Enough staff for 1-1 for each pupil with 1 agency

Flexible options may be required depending on levels of staff absence.

This may include:

- Moving staff between classes to cover for absence in order to maximise class opening.
- Moving to a part time timetable for effected classes.
- Preparing learning packs and activity ideas for those who are asked to work at home for limited periods.

Plan C

Possible closure of named classes for more extended periods with the following expectations.

Classes	Learning expectations
Hazel Oak	A mixture of online learning and learning packs. Some online therapy.
Beech Willow Acorn Pine Maple	Sharing of ideas for practical Educational and Therapeutic activities that can take place in the home or garden. Weekly phone calls to check on progress from class teacher and / or therapist.

Plan D

Return to holiday club style learning with a mixture of onsite/ school -based learning with timings for individual pupils based on the RAG (red, amber, green) rated graduated support needs for families.

RAG rating	School-based learning offer
Red	Full-time offer
Amber	As many days as possible, depending on pupil and staff numbers
Green	Some days as available, depending on pupil and staff numbers

Full school closure.
